Promotion

1. To qualify in a subject, a candidate must obtain minimum Grade D.
2. A student of class IX & X has to qualify by getting 25% mandatory Marks (SA1 + SA2) in each subject separately to be considered for promotion to the next higher class. In case he/she fails to obtain 25% Marks in any of the subjects finally, he/she will be given only one chance to appear for improvement after SA2.
3. Those candidates who obtain Grade E1 or E2 in the subject(s) shall have to improve their performance within one month from the declaration of result to qualify in the subject(s).
4. The student who fails to obtain 25% Marks in a subject in SA1+SA2 after improvement, shall not qualify that subject.

An indicative equivalence of Grade Point and Percentage of Marks can be computed as follows:

Subject wise indicative percentage of marks = 9.5 x G.P. of the subjects

Overall indicative percentage of marks = 9.5 x CGPA

➤ **OPEN TEXT BOOK ASSESSMENT (OTBA)**

The scheme of OTBA has been introduced by CBSE for class IX in SA II in all elective subjects. It's purpose is to develop Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) of students. Text will be provided by CBSE based over the themes in Examination with the questions of 10 marks. Weightage of SA II will remain same viz. 30%.

➤ **ASSESSMENT OF SPEAKING AND LISTENING SKILLS IN ENG. (ASL)**

ASL is applied by CBSE for IX & X for developing listening and speaking skills in English in SA I & SA II. In both SA I & SA II, ASL 20 marks will be included and finally better marks out of two will be taken to add in SA I & SA II marks in class IX & X. For IX & X class, written paper of English in SA I & SA II will be of 70 marks with ASL carrying 20 marks.
